Subject:- Grant of Conditional permission to Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) with 44 seats instead of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 04.10.2024 -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) by an letter reference C-171/SGM/UNI/Appeal/2024-25 dated 09.09.2024 to the commission in respect of Denial of permission to Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in Denial of permission letter dated 05.09.2024.
- Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the hearing letter was issued to the Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) vide Commission's letter Ref. No. NCISM/Comm./Opt. Appeal/(2024-25)-(U.P.) dated 03.10.2024 to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on 04.10.2024 in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the Denial of permission letter dated 05.09.2024 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on 04.10.2024 and on behalf of the college, Dr. Ghazanfar Imam, Principal of the college attended the hearing.
- The hearing committee sought clarification from the representative of the Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) regarding shortcomings mentioned in the Denial of permission letter dated 05.09.2024 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM and observation made by the hearing committee which is as under:-

Shortcoming	Clarification/Document submitted by the College	Observation of the Hearing Committee
1. Functionality of the hospital:	1. Our college is one of the most prestigious colleges in the area and caters the needs of the underprivileged and backward communities. The College was established in 1997 and commenced in 2000 and has received continuous permissions since then.	College submitted released order from superintendent of PHC krangazipur regarding release and handover of the hospital and equipment. Entire hospital building was cleansed and sanitized, that's why regular functioning of the hospital was delayed. The hospital was handover on 18.07.2023. The total no. of patient attended OPD. Average attendance of patient of patient in OPD and average bed occupancy is to be calculated from 18.07.2023 to 31.12.2023 accordingly,
a) Total number of patients attended OPD from 1st Jan, 2023 to 31st Dec, 2023 is 15,515, hence there is a shortcoming of 20485 against the minimum requirement of 36000.	2. For the academic session 2024-25, the College was visited on 27.05.2024 and 28.05.2024 on Hybrid mode by the visitation team of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine. Even though the College fulfilled all requirements and the visitation was fully carried out on 27.05.2024 and 28.05.2024. The College has all the requisite faculty which meets the requirements as per the MSR. With respect to the inspection conducted on 27.05.2024 and 28.05.2024.	Submission may be considered.
b) Average attendance of Patient in OPD per day	3. It is to inform you about functionality of our hospital that Sham-e-Ghausia Minority (SGM) Unani Medical College Hospital, Saheri, Ghazipur was acquired by the District Administration, Ghazipur by order passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sadar Ghazipur vide his Letter No. 233/आ.सि. dated on 16.04.2021 (copy enclosed) as per the order of the Government of Uttar Pradesh during the corona transition period. After the end of the corona transition, I have tried for release of our hospital on repeated written requests before the District Administration, Ghazipur as well as Chief Medical Officer, Ghazipur, vide our request Letter No. C-65/SGM(PG)/AY-22 dated 05.05.2022(copy enclosed) & C-	

is 51.72, hence there is a shortcoming of 68.28 against the minimum requirement of 120. c) Average Bed occupancy is 13.08, hence there is a shortcoming of 26.92 against the minimum requirement of 40.	117/SGM(AG)/AY-22 dated 02.07.2022(copy enclosed)and again requested before them by our letter no. C-130/SGM(PG)/AY-22 dated 20.07.2022. (copy enclosed) But Chief Medical Officer, Ghazipur has issued letter regarding no released of our hospital because no any direction or guideline has been issued by the Govt. of UP in this regard by the letter no. मुं०चि०अ०/अधि०चि०/2022-23/2353-3 dated 28.07.2022. (copy enclosed) After that i have continued tried and personally meet to The District Magistrate, Ghazipur and requested to release our acquired hospital. The District Magistrate, Ghazipur has issued the released order wide letter no. कोविड/चि०/अवमुक्त/2023-24/708 dated 10.05.2023(copy enclosed) by email received on 16.05.2023. Incompliance to the letter receiving the releasing order by District Magistrate, Ghazipur we had written requested to Chief Medical Office/The Nodal Officer corona control unit, Ghazipur by the letter no. C- 116/SGMAU/2023 dated 18.05.2023 (copy enclosed) & C-123/SGMAU/2023 dated 27.05.2023(copy enclosed) and they have taken back all its goods and equipment and released the hospital building and handed it over to the undersigned on 18.07.2023 (released order is enclosed). In this sequence, it is a pleasure to inform you that the college management is now functioning the entire hospital from 21.08.2023 after cleaning and painting the entire hospital building, all the departments of the hospital i.e. outdoor department, Indoor department, laboratories, ilaj bit tadbeer section, operation theatre, minor OT, labour room and drug distribution unit etc. with fully functional as per the norms of NCISM/MSR2016. 4. Again, the NCISM was conducted a Hearing on 19.07.2024 by virtual mode and the college was submitted on above real facts before the designated hearing members and hearing members also verified our submission in this regard. 5. To the College's utter shock and surprise, the impugned denial order dated 05.09.2024 was issued on the erroneous ground that the College. 6. The College has been running since 2000 and has continuous permissions since then. It has all the requisite teaching and non-teaching staff and there is no shortcoming whatsoever. The College is an important avenue for the students in the backward areas and communities and no public interest will be served in denying permission to the College on entirely erroneous grounds. 7. When the surprise visit was held on 27-28/05/2024 and visitors took the group photos in the early morning and visited the college and hospital and found all the teaching and hospital staffs to working and found fully functional. 8. It is requested that the counselling process for admissions for the present academic year has commenced and therefore, the present appeal be decided expeditiously and permission be granted to the College. 9. Keeping the above real facts kindly consider the same regarding our above submission do the needful.	
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4. The submission made by the **representative of Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310)** and observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to **consider the appeal regarding Grant of permission in UG (BUMS) course to Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) for the academic session 2024-25 as per rules.**
5. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide letter no. **NCISM/Comm/OPT Appeal/ (2024-25)- (U.P) dated 16.10.2024** to grant permission to **Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310) in UG (BUMS) course** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 as per the concerned acts & regulations.
6. Accordingly assessment report has been carefully re-examined after considering the observation of the designated committee and in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder **and college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for grant of conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course. However, President Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM instructed to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2024-25.**

Therefore, as per the approved seat reduction policy-

- A. **"For every 1% deficiency in bed occupancy, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat"**

Availability of Average bed occupancy percentage after considering the submissions made by the college during appeal is 26.17% and there is a shortcoming of 14%. **Therefore, intake strength is reduced by 14 seats.**

- B. **"For every 10% deficiency in Average attendance of patients in OPD per day seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat."**

Availability of Average attendance of patients in OPD per day after considering the submissions made by the college during appeal is 103.43% and there is a shortcoming of 17% which is rounded off to 20%. Therefore, intake strength is reduced by 02 seats.

Therefore, after applying the seat Reduction Policy College is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 44 seats instead of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.

7. Therefore, conditional permission is granted to **Sham-e-Ghausia Minority Unani Medical College & Hospital, Saheri, Via- Nandganj, Ghazipur-233001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0310)** 44 seats instead of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
 - (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats** of the permitted intake capacity of **44 seats instead of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26 as per rules:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
12. **The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.**
